Presbyter's Message

Greetings to you in the precious name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

In the spring of 30 AD --- on the day we now call Palm Sunday --- Jesus made his triumphant entry into Jerusalem. As He entered the city, the people hailed Him, shouting, "Hosanna! Hosanna to the King! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!" they laid down their coats and spread Palm branches for Him to ride on. This was the beginning of Jesus' last week on Earth.

As the week progressed, all of the praise He received Sunday, the shouting and singing, was over. It was replaced by jeers, mockery and shouts of crucifixion. The same people who were praising on Sunday soon shouted for the blood of the Son of God .By the end of the week, Jesus was arrested, given a mockery of a trail, beaten and scourged beyond human likeness, crucified, laid in a tomb and rise again on the third day. That day — Resurrection Sunday — has become the pivotal point of history. It was the day that confirmed and sealed the eternal destiny of all believers and non-believers.

The Passover and Easter season is one of the most significant times in the history of our world. The events of this week changed the eternal destiny of man. This week was the culmination of the plan of salvation the Father set in place before the foundations of the world were laid. This is not to take anything away from the Christmas season, the birth of Jesus, but Easter is what Christmas is all about. John 3:16 says, "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." The Father so loved us, so treasured us and so valued us that he sent Jesus to redeem, justify, reconcile and restore us to the place and position the Father created us to live in. His intense love for us is why He did it. Grace is how He did it.

All that Jesus went through was so that we could be redeemed and reconciled to the Father. It was the ultimate demonstration of God's love for us. Jesus laid his life down so that we could have eternal life in the presence of the Father.

Jesus came to destroy the works of the devil. He came to seek and save the lost. He came to make the way by which everyone who desires to be could be saved. He came to reveal the heart of the Father to His children. He came to demonstrate the love the Father has for us.

The ultimate question of life is, "Have we received His love, accepted His abundant provision of grace and His gift of righteousness?" His plan is so perfect, no devil can stop us from receiving it. But have we accepted his plan for salvation.

As we will be celebrating Easter, let us receive His love His grace and His Providence. May this Easter season be a lot more than new clothes and a big family meal. May it be the time we receive the gift the Father has given and promised for each and every one of us.
